## Annex I

### POSITIONS FOR ELECTION/NOMINATIONS INTO THE GENERAL COUNCIL (BOARD) OF MCSN

In line with Article 35 of the Society's Articles of Association, the following positions (vacancies) shall for the time being be filled by election and nominations which shall be ratified at an Annual General Meeting:

1. Six members divided into the following categories:
  - a. Four composer/writer members to represent as far as possible the known music genres/rights such as Juju, Fuji, Gospel, Reggae, High Life, Hip Hop, etc.
  - b. Two publisher members
2. Nominations from each of the following associations or Guilds with subsisting representation agreements with the Society in the following order:
  - a. Two nominations from the Performing Musicians' Employers' Association of Nigeria (PMAN).
  - b. One nomination each from registered or incorporated associations or groups with which the Society has entered into copyright collective management representation agreement on behalf of their members and affiliates.

#### **N.B.**

- a. *The names of nominations for elections and appointments once received shall be published for final elections and, or ratifications at the following or next Annual/Extra-Ordinary General Meeting. Method of election shall also be notified in advance.*
